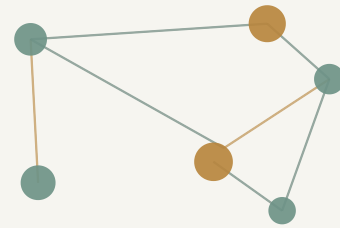

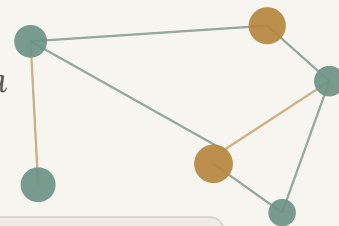

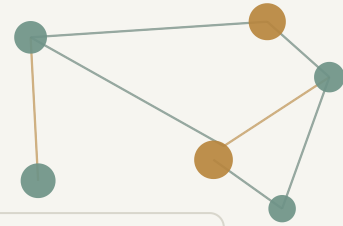

Two linked sessions carry the day from discovery through to a concrete plan of action.

**MORNING • DISCOVERY**

Discovery of Synergies

A structured, facilitated mapping exercise — bring your current research questions.

What are you currently researching that you are open to collaborating on? Together, we'll join the dots on current research, identify potential synergies, and populate a shared AICBRN opportunity database.

AFTERNOON • ACTION

Collaboration for Impact

Collaboration concepts surfaced in the morning Discovery session are solidified. Participants leave with concrete collaboration actions mapped against upcoming opportunities.

Nearest station: Drumcondra — direct connections from both Dublin Connolly and Dublin Heuston. A 20-minute walk from the venue, or connect onward by Dublin Bus.

Drumcondra Rd Lower, to the west of campus, is served by Dublin Bus and is a short walk to the venue.

Bike Parking

Racks are located throughout the All Hallows campus; the nearest to the venue is outside Purcell House.

Parking on campus

A visitor day parking pass MUST be registered before the event — approval is required before the €3/day rate can be paid. If parking in a general 'Pay for Parking' space without a valid pass, **vehicles risk being clamped and towed**. Allow 4–5 minutes to complete parking pass registration and when prompted enter DCU staff contact name as "Kirsten Corcoran".

Campus Map

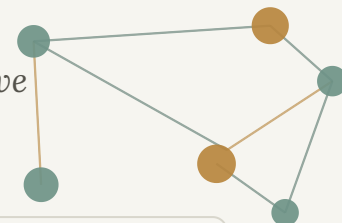


Pedestrian entrance off Church Ave; car entrance from Grace Park Road. Car Parks 1 and 2 are labelled CP1 / CP2.

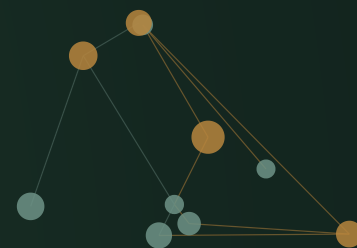
